1. What would you like to do in Canada?

Options: Visit (Tourism, Business, Family or Friend visit), Study, Move there, Work, Transit – less than 48 hours, IEC – travel & work.

2. How long are you planning to stay in Canada?

Options: Temporarily – LESS than 6 months, temporarily – MORE than 6 months, or permanently

3. What is your code that matches the one on your passport?

4. What is your current country/territory of residence?

5. Do you have a family member who is a Canadian citizen or permanent resident and is 18 years or older?

6. What is your date of birth (YYYY/MM/DD):

7. Have you lived in Canada as a permanent resident or landed immigrant?

8. Are you a lawful permanent resident of the United States with a valid U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) number?

9. What is your marital status?

Options: Married, Legally Separated, Divorced, Annulled Marriage, Widowed, Common-law, or Single

10. What is your province or territory of destination in Canada? **If visiting multiple provinces or territories, select the one in which you will be spending most of your time.**

Options: Alberta, British Columbia, Manitoba, New Brunswick, Newfoundland and Labrador, Northwest Territories, Nova Scotia, Nunavut, Ontario, Prince Edward Island, Quebec, Saskatchewan, Yukon

11. What is the main purpose of your visit?

Options: To visit family and/or friends, to conduct business, tourism, to attend an interview as part of the provincial nominee program

If going to visit for a family/friend visit:

- Do you have proof of your relationship with the person who is inviting you to Canada?
- Do you have a job in the country where you are currently live?
- Do you own a business in the country where you currently live?
- Do you depend on someone for financial support?
- Have you travelled to other countries in the previous 10 years?

If going on business:

What type of business will you be conducting in Canada?

Options:

- Want to conduct business activities but will not enter the Canadian labour market.
- Want to purchase goods and services for a foreign business or government, and/or go on training related to these goods and services.
- Want to take or give training with a Canadian corporation that employs me outside of Canada. Goods and services received from the training is incidental.
- I am representing a foreign business or government and want to sell goods on behalf of the business or government (no sales to the general public).

If going on tourism:

- Do you have proof of your relationship with the person who is inviting you to Canada?
- Do you have a job in the country where you currently live?
- Do you own a business in the country where you currently live?
- Do you depend on someone for financial support?
- Have you travelled to other countries in the previous 10 years?

12. Are you accompanying a family member that has status in Canada, or has recently been approved to come to Canada?

13. Have you ever committed, been arrested for, been charged with, or convicted of any criminal offence in any country?

14. Have you had a medical exam performed by an IRCC authorized panel physician (doctor) within the last 12 months?

15. Do you want to submit an application for a family member?

16. In the past 10 years, have you given your fingerprints and photo (biometrics) for an application to come to Canada?

MANDATORY DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR CANADA APPLICATION:

- IMM5257 – Application for visitor visa.
- IMM5707 – Family information.
- IMM5476 – Rep form.
- Copy of a valid passport.
- Copy of any previous Canada visa (if applicable).
- Copy of any other valid visas or previous visas (if applicable) – this shows your travel history.
- Copy of USA visa (if applicable).
- Digital photo (can be a selfie taken with your phone).
- Dummy flights (must show traveller's name & surname) – **DO NOT purchase flight tickets until your visa has been approved.**
- Dummy accommodation (must show all travellers names & surnames) – **DO NOT purchase confirmed hotel bookings until your visa has been approved.**
- Most recent 3-month stamped bank statements in English with enough funds.
- **Business travellers:** A signed letter of invitation.
- **Family/ Friend travellers:** A signed letter of invitation, with a copy of the inviter's passport & utility bill.

NOTE: Additional documents may be requested during your application.
